

Edmund Martin & Wife & Mary Juggins, 100 Acres, Harrison Ex^d
Delivers Mr. Haymond

Robert Brooke Esquire, Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to all to whom these presents shall come Greeting. Know ye, that by virtue of a Certificate in right of Settlement given by the Commissioners for adjusting the titles to unpatented Lands in the District of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio and in consideration of the Ancient Composition of two pounds Sterling paid into the Treasury of this Commonwealth there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto Edmund Martin and Elizabeth his Wife one Moiety and unto Mary Juggins the other Moiety, the said Elizabeth and Mary being Daughters and Heiresses of John Juggins deceased, a certain tract or parcel of Land containing four Hundred Acres, by survey bearing date the thirteenth day of December, one Thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, lying and being in the County of Harrison on Juggins run, a drain of Bartleys run and bounded as followeth to wit: Beginning at a white oak on the South side of the said Juggins's run and running thence South fifty eight degrees East three hundred and thirty poles to a Hickory and dogwood, North twenty eight degrees East one hundred and ninety four poles to a white oak, North fifty eight degrees West three hundred and thirty poles to a white oak, South twenty eight degrees West one hundred and ninety four poles to the beginning, with its appurtenances to have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to the said Edmund Martin and Elizabeth his wife & to Mary Juggins & their Heirs for ever, In Witness whereof the said Robert Brooke hath hereunto set his hand & caused the lesser Seal of the said Commonwealth to be affixed at Richmond on the twenty seventh day of December in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and of the Commonwealth the nineteenth.
